Morristown High School is a comprehensive four-year secondary school that serves a diverse population of over 1900 students, led by a staff of 167 educators (two-thirds of whom have advanced degrees). We are located in Morristown, NJ, a vibrant, cosmopolitan suburb rich in history and culture. Our students avail themselves of the many opportunities provided by our local museums, historic sites, performing arts venues, colleges and universities, and civic institutions.

MHS provides a rigorous college preparatory curriculum, including 28 Advanced Placement, 3 Post-Secondary, and 40 Honors courses, complemented by a full range of co-curricular activities as well as 30 varsity athletic teams. Accredited by the NJ Department of Education, MHS stands out among peer high schools for its programs in STEM, Humanities, broadcasting, music, and theatre.

As part of our commitment to graduating students with well-developed global competency, MHS participates in the NJ State Seal of Biliteracy Program, which grants certification of demonstrated linguistic proficiency in English as well as a second world language. Our official partnership with CIEE offers students Global Navigator Scholarships for life-changing study abroad experiences, with an emphasis on intercultural awareness and communication skills.

INNOVATIVE PROGRAMS

Humanities Academy

Multidisciplinary course of study rooted in the theoretical and methodological principles of Design Thinking; culminates in a capstone research project and public presentation on the student's chosen topic of interest.

Music Education and Performance

Curricular and extra-curricular programs in symphonic band, wind ensemble, orchestra, concert choir, marching band, jazz band, jazz voice ensemble, and women's glee club. Students have access to a range of performance options, including concerts, competitions, showcases, and honor ensembles.

Peer Group Connection

Accredited leadership program designed by the Princeton Center for Learning; student leaders are carefully selected and trained to provide peer mentoring and facilitate discussions about healthy choices and life skills with younger students.

STEM Academy

Highly selective, four-year program (by application only) that offers students specialized instruction, field experience, professional mentoring, and co-curricular activities in a number of pathways: Biomedicine, Engineering, Architecture, Environmental Sustainability, Computer Science, Mathematics and General STEM.

Tech Ed: Communication and Media Studies

Integrated studies in media history, theory, research and management with production work in film, audio, video, and digital media; course of study includes photographic imaging, graphic design, broadcasting (TV and radio), and filmmaking. Morristown High School has a student-run public radio station, WJSV (90.5 FM; WJSVFM.com), as well as a television studio, where students produce the biweekly Colonial Corner, available on YouTube.

Tech Ed: Engineering and Design

Focus area based on the DIY or Maker movement, drawing on open-source methods and innovative technology; coursework in Computer Assisted Design (CAD), engineering, architecture, robotics, alternative energy and sustainable design.

Theatre Arts

Coursework in acting and in public speaking; audition-only production of a yearly dramatic or comedic work (fall) and musical (spring), offering ancillary opportunities in set design, hair and makeup, costuming, lighting, sound, publicity, and playbill copywriting, editing, and layout.

Instructional Schedule

Morristown High School operates on an A-Day/B-Day schedule (80 minute sessions), which integrates full year and semester courses. Students are not limited in the number of AP, PS, or Honors courses they can take. Morristown High School does not offer IB courses.

Course Designations

Courses are designated by level of difficulty as follows:

- **AP** Advanced Placement
- **PS** Post-Secondary
- H Honors
- A Academic

All Honors, Post-Secondary, and AP courses are weighted in the calculation of the GPA. Only academic coursework taken at MHS and approved by the MSD BOE is included in the GPA.

Grading System

Morristown High School rates student performance relative to the following scale. Honors and Post-Secondary courses are weighed into the scale by factoring a multiplier of 1.25 to the value of the letter grade and AP courses are weighed into the scale by factoring a multiplier of 1.5 to the value of the letter grade.




