Know what it means to refer back to the story for text support.

Decode and determine the meaning of tricky words.

Encourage your child's reading at home each night to build reading stamina and practice reading fluently.

Discuss the book your child is reading with him/her.

Ask your child questions about the book. Then ask him/her to provide you with evidence from the text to support the answers.
